City Problem Guidelines

- 1. <u>Identify</u> a problem in your City at Wyoming Girls State (ex, Litter Control, Water Supply, Recycling, etc)
 - ✓ Be Creative ... involve all citizens in your city for selection ideas
 - ✓ Consider the problem's impact ... on your city, other cities, in the future of Wyo GS

2. <u>Components</u> of the solution

Prepare a 3-dimensional product to illustrate the problem and the solution (use the cardboard display board) <u>Resources that can be used:</u>

- ✓ Anything the delegates brought from home
- ✓ Supplies given to the City by WY GS
- ✓ Purchased items (limited to \$20); must be coordinated with commissary; tracked by City Treasurer
- ✓ Dirt, sand, rocks, weeds, grass, twigs, pine cones, etc. (within reason from outside)

Resources that may NOT be used:

- ✓ <u>ANYTHING</u> from the cafeteria (ex. Salt/pepper shakers, glasses, silverware, cartons, uneaten food, etc.)
- ✓ Items from the trash or dumpster (a box from the Commissary is okay)
- ✓ Branches from trees, bushes, or flowers

A PREPARED PRESENTATION EXPLAINING THE City Problem and Solution

- ✓ Only City residents may be involved in the presentation of the City's Problem and Solution
- ✓ Limited the presentation to 3 minutes (Maximum)
- Presenters may use notes to the presentation and should use the 3-D model to illustrate the problem and solution.
- ✓ Question and answer period to be no longer than 2 minutes.

"Question & Answer" session to clarify the problem & solution (2 minutes max)

- \checkmark Following the presentation the audience may ask questions about the problem
- ✓ Mayor and key City leaders will need to be available for follow-up questions by judging team

<u>SUBMIT a WRITTEN FORM</u> (provided to your City) with an outline of the "City Problem" and "Solution" ... <u>with Official Signatures</u> include at First Page in City Manual provided at the <u>TIME OF</u> <u>PRESENTATION.</u> Three ring binders will be provided to put these forms in.
