

GIRLS STATE JOB DESCRIPTION

Title: Americanism

You are in charge of the flag ceremonies. The cities will be assigned days for flag raising and lowering. The Junior Counselors will do the Sunday morning flag raising. You should bring along some materials for the Delegates to use - songs, poems, readings, etc. - to help them with the ceremony. You will have a Junior Counselor to help you in any way you wish.

You will be in charge of telling the Delegates what theme is to be used for their Patriotic Presentation/City Problem, what night it will be, that it should be only five (5) minutes long, and to use a serious theme. You can get ideas from the other staff or past chairman. Arrange for judges and how presentation will be scored. Will count towards the Outstanding City Award.

You will be in charge of the Americanism test, taken from the book "Flag Etiquette" and the Constitution. The test is usually only fifteen (15) minutes long, and is a collection of true/false, multiple choice and fill in the blank questions, 30-50 total. There will be one Senior and one Junior Counselor in each city while the test is being given. NAMES MUST BE ON THE TEST, plus the Delegate's Girls State City. The reason for this - high scorers are used in various ways during the Inauguration. When using the high scorers for the Inauguration, you will work with the Special Events Coordinator.

Inventory Americanism Presentation and provide a list of supplies on hand and supplies needed for next year.

You may be a Senior Counselor with an assigned city and will work with the Junior Counselor assigned to your city to help keep track of the Delegates in the dorm and to keep order. You will attend all city meetings. Guidelines for City Counselors will be in the packets.

You must maintain proper conduct, as the Delegates should see you as an example of a dignified leader.

If you have free time, you may attend any of the sessions you wish.
