Outstanding Citizen (possibly change to Delegate) Guidelines

- Senior and Junior Counselors select two Delegates from each area of the program. (Education, Parties, Electives, Cities, and Americanism)
- Delegates are selected for the following qualities excelling in their area, personal growth, contributing to the program, and assisting others.
- The Speaker of the House, President of the Senate, Nationalist Party Leader, and Federalist Party Leader all receive gavels in recognition of their election to these offices at the graduation ceremony. (Therefore, other Delegates should be recognized.)
- Court needs to note which Delegate has been selected to receive the Outstanding Court Gavel at the graduation ceremony.
- Nomination forms are due by Thursday morning at Staff Meeting.
- This recognition will be included on the Delegates' graduation diplomas. However, the nominating Staff may wish to create individual certificates to include in the graduation folders.

Outstanding Girls State Citizen (possibly change to Delegate) Guidelines

- This recognition is determined by the Director and the Assistant Director, who may ask the other Girls State Staff members for their input.
- Criteria to be used to select the Delegate may include personal growth, overcoming adversity, contributing to the program, assisting others, excelling in the day to day activities of the program - a Delegate who exemplifies the image of an "all-around Girls State Delegate".
- The selected Delegate will receive a Certificate and a Citizenship Medal to be awarded during the graduation ceremony.
