SPECIFICATIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

NOTE: Specifications may vary from year to year. Recipients should check with the Financial Aid Office for exact specifications of any scholarship they are awarded.

UNIVERSITY OF WYOMING - LARAMIE

This scholarship will cover tuition and mandatory university-wide fees. Not renewable. Point of information - Realize that this scholarship may not be held concurrently with any tuition & fees scholarship, such as the President's Honor, Trustee's Superior Student, etc.

CASPER COLLEGE - CASPER

A tuition scholarship - will pay standard tuition and fees for two semesters. Not renewable. Multiple tuition policy - therefore student can accept only one scholarship designated for tuition.

CENTRAL WYOMING COLLEGE - RIVERTON

A general academic tuition and general fee scholarship for the academic year. The student must attend fulltime. Scholarship is renewable as long as the student completes a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester with a 3.0 GPA.

EASTERN WYOMING COLLEGE - TORRINGTON

Tuition waiver is available for two semesters. Recipient must have a GPA of at least 3.00 to initially receive. To renew for the second semester, student must have a GPA of 2.5. Scholarship must be used in the Fall immediately following high school graduation.

LARAMIE COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE - CHEYENNE

Tuition scholarship subject to following conditions: The award will be valid for academic year. Will cover full-time resident tuition and mandatory fees for two semesters. To receive the first semester award, the student must enroll full-time (at least 12 credits) at LCCC during Fall Semester. The scholarship is renewable for a second semester if student successfully completes 12 or more credits during the first semester with a minimum semester GPA 2.0 and enrolls full-time for the Spring semester.

NORTHWEST COLLEGE - POWELL

This scholarship for one year will cover the amount of tuition. The recipient will receive one-half of the scholarship each semester.

SHERIDAN COLLEGE - SHERIDAN

A \$1000 scholarship – renewable contingent on recipient completing not less than 12 credit hours and maintaining a GPA not less than 2.5 each semester. Scholarship to be used for attendance immediately following graduation from High School.

WESTERN WYOMING COMMUNITY COLLEGE - ROCK SPRINGS

Scholarship to be used for attendance immediately following graduation from High School. Recipient must have a minimum GPA of 3.00. The scholarship covers in-state tuition and required fees.

WYOMING GIRLS STATE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship in the amount of \$500.00 can be used at any accredited school, be it in Wyoming or out of state, and can include any Vocational Education School or Community College. Financial need and family size will be main considerations in selecting the recipient.

SAMSUNG AMERICAN LEGION SCHOLARSHIP

Student must be a direct descendant, i.e., child, grandchild, great-grandchild or a legally adopted child, of an U.S. veteran who served during a period of war. The scholarship may be used for undergraduate study only at an accredited U.S. college or university. Wyoming Girls State recipient receives upwards to \$1,100.00 scholarship and application is sent to National for upwards to \$20,000 scholarship. **NOTE:** There is a separate application for the Samsung Scholarship available from the local Girls State Chairman. Begin working on this immediately, as it will require researching for military information and documents. The Samsung Scholarship application must be typed and the deadline is also May 1, 2015.

ALEX FRYE YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP

One-time scholarship in the amount of \$600.00 to be used for tuition, fees or room and board paid by the Alexander G. Frye Charitable Fund. This scholarship may be used in any university, college, junior college, or approved vocation/trade education school in the United States. Recipient must be a resident of the state of Wyoming or military child stationed in Wyoming at the time of application. **NOTE**: There is a separate application for the Alex Frye Youth Scholarship available from the local Girls State Chairman. The deadline is also May 1, 2015.
